Summary of Fees 2011

Horowhenua College is a member of the ODENZ Group (Outdoor Education New Zealand)

Tuition Fee

Basic uniform is provided **at no extra charge**

• **There are:**

- **No additional airport pick-up charges from Palmerston North or Wellington**
- **NEW: Pick-up/escort from Auckland Airport (service on request for additional charge)**
- **No homestay placement fee**
- **No uniform charges**

- The full year fee for tuition is NZ\$9,500 (including Goods & Services Tax) until June 2011.
- The school charges an additional administration fee of NZ\$1,000.
- The school charges a Pastoral Care fee of NZ\$250 per term
- The incidental allowance of NZ\$500 is optional to cover costs for items like write-on text books and stationery
- Insurance cost depending on the length of stay
- Please note that the above charges apply for the 2011 academic year.
- Fees are reviewed annually.
- The tuition fee paid at the start of the year will not be increased during that year
- Tuition Fees above includes: homestay placement, ID card, locker, school magazine and basic items of uniform when necessary* (students need to bring their own black winter shoes).

Uniform

When a student begins their stay at Horowhenua College they will receive the following uniform. As a student outgrows their uniform or moves into the senior school, replacements are provided for.

Seniors

One pair of plain black trousers (boys)
 One black knee length skirt (girls)
 Two white shirts (boy)
 Two white blouse (girl)
 One red jersey

Juniors

One plain dark blue College trousers (boys)
 One knee length red and blue checked skirt (girls)
 Two blue shirts (boys and girls)
 Sports uniform (one pair shorts and one shirt)

International students also have the opportunity to go on special trips at different times during the year. The cost of these trips vary depending on the distance travelled and length of time away.

Occasionally some senior subjects do not run due to low numbers of students wishing to take them. Such subjects, if required, will be available at an extra cost for distance learning (\$NZ 1,900 for one year) through the Correspondence School.

Latin, if required, will be available at extra cost for distance learning and tutoring through Correspondence School (\$NZ1,700 for one year) or students may bring their own Latin material to work on with teacher support provided by the College.

NEW: Extra ESOL classes

Horowhenua College will be offering extra ESOL classes after school, \$300 for 10 ½ hour lessons over 10 weeks (one session per week). Starting date 1 August 2011.

Homestay fees

In 2011 the homestay fee will remain at NZ\$200 per week in 2011. In 2012, the homestay fee will increase to NZ\$220.

Students are met on arrival at the beginning of their time in New Zealand at Palmerston North or Wellington International Airports – no fee charged.

Insurance

May be organized in the home country or by Horowhenua College and varies depending on the length of stay. For example, currently NZ\$506.20 for 52 weeks (full year) and NZ\$158.72 for 12 weeks duration.

Refund of Fees

Refunds of fees will only be made where special circumstances such as significant health problems or extreme family circumstances necessitate the student's return to his or her own country. All international student fees are protected by being held in a Trust Account in case a refund is required.

The Board of Trustees guarantees that expenditure of course fees remain in proportion to the proportion of the course delivered. The Board guarantees to refund fees in proportion to any part of a course it is unable to continue to deliver.
